Due to the success of AEM2C2010 in Taipei, IEEE iWEM (IEEE International Workshop on Electromagnetics: Applications and Student Innovation Competition) was proposed and discussed by the Scientific Committees of AEM2C. Finally, IEEE iWEM was decided as the future name instead of AEM2C. The next four workshops were also decided as follows: IEEE iWEM2011 in Taiwan, IEEE iWEM2012 in China, IEEE iWEM2013 in Hong Kong, and IEEE iWEM2014 in Japan. The Workshop and Innovation Competition provide a unified and unique international forum for the Applications of Electromagnetism and Innovations in the field, as well as an opportunity to exchange ideas with others in the area of Electromagnetics. The workshop will include not only paper presentations, but also will have awards for the best paper and the Student Innovation Competition. The topics covered by the IEEE iWEM include Applications of Antennas, Propagation, Measurement, EM Theory, and EM simulation, and other related topics are also welcome.
